KS1 visit to Bolsover Castle, Bolsover – Wednesday 11th March 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to offer a trip to Bolsover Castle to support our Enquiry learning about 'What makes Britain great?' in a local historical spot. During the trip, children will get the chance to explore the castle grounds and see artefacts from various periods in history. This is a joint trip with Poolsbrook Primary, who we work alongside with closely.

Trip Details:

Date: Wednesday 11th March 2026

Cost: Subsidised cost of £8.20 per child (includes coach transport)

Arrival at School: 8:30 am (departing from school at 9am)

Return to School: Approximately 3:15 pm (children can be collected from their classrooms as usual)

Lunch Arrangements:

All children will need a packed lunch which they will be able to eat in the beautiful outdoor gardens. We discourage children from bringing lunchboxes as these can be bulky and uncomfortable for the children to carry. Children should also bring their water bottle as usual. **If your child has any dietary requirements, please contact the office to inform us.**

For children entitled to Universal Free School Meals, we can provide a packed lunch upon request. Please call the office if this is required.

Important Reminders:

Children should wear their school uniform or PE kit, appropriate for the weather. We will be informed by the weather forecast nearer to the time and inform you about what additional clothing your child may need.

Any required sickness tablets should be administered at home before the morning departure. We are no longer able to administer sickness tablets throughout the day.

Consent and Payment:

A visit consent form is enclosed and must be completed and returned to school. Unfortunately, without this form, your child will not be able to attend the trip.

Please ensure the contribution of £8.20 is made via ParentPay and the consent form is returned by **Wednesday 11th February 2026**. Please understand that if we cannot cover of the cost of the visit, we will have no choice but to cancel it.
